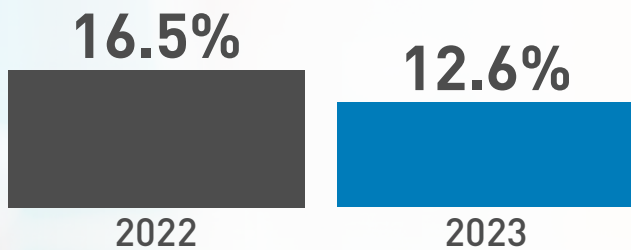


### Findings from the 2023 National Youth Tobacco Survey

Current tobacco use **decreased** among high school students

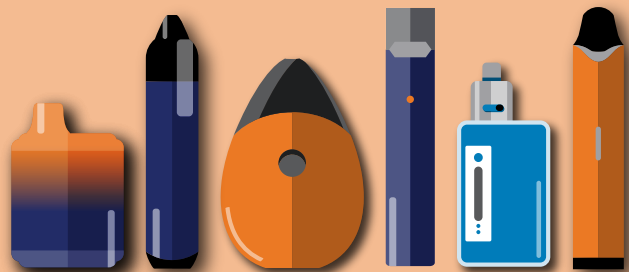


Driven by a drop in high school e-cigarette use

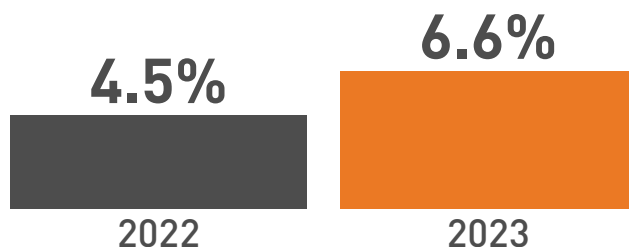


But there's more work to be done to build on this progress...

**E-Cigarettes** were the most popular tobacco product for the 10<sup>th</sup> year in a row



Current tobacco use **increased** among middle school students



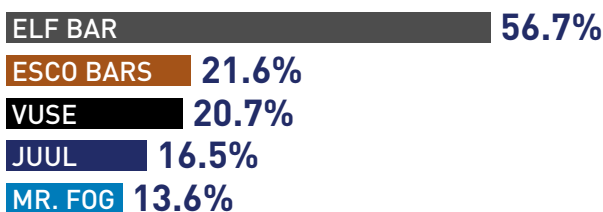
More than **2.1 million youth** currently used e-cigarettes

Among youth who reported current use of e-cigarettes:

More than **1 in 4**



The most commonly reported brands were:



Almost **9 out of 10**



Youth use of tobacco products in any form—including e-cigarettes—is unsafe. Keeping tobacco products out of the hands of youth remains a top priority for the FDA.
